Health Insurance 2 Options (International students are only on one of these plans which is dependent on their eligibility – whether they have a MSI card or not):	
1. International Emergency Health Insurance – for students who do not have Nova Scotia Health Cards (also known as the MSI card). This is an emergency medical plan only. Some dental is covered in cases of a medical emergency.	\$650
2. Student Health & Dental Plan This plan is for students with valid Nova Scotia Health Card (also known as the MSI card).	\$242
Student Association Fee (varies by campus)	\$50-\$100
U-Pass (only required for Metro Campus Students)	\$173
Parking Pass – Optional (pass is required to park on NSCC property)	\$20

Programs Starting in September 2017	1st Term Payment Due: <u>August 4, 2017</u> (50% Tuition + Student Association Fee + International Student fee + Insurance + College Services Fee). Payment includes a \$400 non-refundable tuition deposit. If you've already paid the \$400 tuition deposit your payment total will be decreased by \$400. 2nd Term Payment Due: <u>January 5, 2018</u> (50% Tuition)
Programs starting in January 2018	1st Term Payment Due: <u>November 22, 2017</u> (50% Tuition + Student Association Fee + Health & Dental Plan + College Services Fee). Payment includes a \$200 non-refundable tuition deposit. If you've already paid the \$200 tuition deposit your payment total will be decreased by \$200.
