

International Student Guide: Letter of Invitation

Letter of Invitation

A letter of invitation is used to support an <u>application for a TRV</u> for a family member or friend from your home country who wants to visit you in Canada.

This letter is written by you - the student. It does not guarantee that a visa will be issued. Visa officers assess the applicant to determine whether they meet the requirements of the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act and Regulations.

Students must complete 6 months of study to invite family members or friends.

A letter of invitation will be submitted with the application when the family member applies to enter Canada. The purpose of the visit may be to attend your graduation or just to visit you. You must make sure you send the letter to them at your earliest convenience to accommodate IRCC processing times for this application.

Please Note: Do not use your personal MyCIC account to apply for a visitor visa application for a family member. Your family member should create their own account if they apply online.

Writing the Letter

You **must** include this information about **the person you are inviting**:

- complete name
- date of birth
- address and telephone number
- your relationship to the person
- the purpose of the trip
- how long the person plans to stay in Canada
- where the person will stay, and how he or she will pay for things
- when the person plans to leave Canada

You must include this information about yourself:

- complete name
- date of birth
- address and telephone number in Canada
- job title (if applicable)
- copy of your study/work permit and passport pages
- copy of your transcript
- details of your family, such as names and dates of birth of your spouse and dependants
- the total number of people living in your household



Additional Documents

You can also provide the following documents to support your invitation:

- Copies of your passport pages
- Letter of confirmation of enrollment from NSCC
- If you are directly responsible for your family member's expenses, provide proof of means of financial support

Refer to the sample letters below for help.

Important Information for the Applicant (the person visiting you)

Remember – your letter is only part of the support of the application. Your family member/friend should ensure they submit a complete application for a TRV. Some visa offices may require the letter of invitation to be notarized. You can check this website to see where they need to submit their application.

The applicant must provide proof of economic and/or social ties to their home country. They must prove to Visa Officers that they will return to their home country after visiting Canada.

Economic ties include: Bank statements, proof of financial investments, letters of employment, proof of business ownership, proof of property ownership, etc.

Social ties include: Evidence that family members back home depend on them for financial /social support and that they must return home after their visit in order to meet these social obligations (letters, school records, shared bills, etc.)
