



International Student Guide: Apply for Initial Study Permit from Inside Canada (for exchange students)

Visiting or exchange students who have visitor status can apply for an initial study permit from inside Canada (online).

If your passport will expire soon, you must apply for a new passport **before** applying for your study permit. Also, if you intend to work in Canada after you graduate, you will need a valid study permit when you apply for your post-graduate work permit. Ensure you have 3 extra months after your studies officially end.

Please note these instructions are general, and do not address specific personal situations. If you have any questions, be sure to contact NSCC International before proceeding.

Follow these steps to apply for your initial study permit online:

1. Create your MyCIC account using GCKey or Sign-in Partner/Log into MyCIC

If you are a new user, you will need to create your MyCIC account through GCKey or Sign-in Partner at www.cic.gc.ca/english/e-services/mycic.asp.

1. Complete the questionnaire

Scroll down to "**Start an Application**", and choose "**Apply to come to Canada**". You should not have a personal reference code at this time, so scroll down to "**I do not have a Personal Reference Code**", and click on:

Visitor, study and/or work permit

*Please note – **not all** questions are listed below. Provide answers based on what is true for you. However, you must input the following:*

Determine your Eligibility	Answers
What would you like to do in Canada?	Study
How long are you planning to stay in Canada?	Temporarily – more than 6 months
What is your current country of residence?	Canada
What is your current immigration status in Canada?	Visitor

After you select "Visitor", you will be directed to a new link. Choose "**Yes**" for the first option, and "**no**" for the rest.



Find out if you're eligible to apply

Does one of the following apply to you?

- I am subject of a removal order that is unenforceable
- I applied for a study or work permit before entering Canada which was approved, but not issued at a port of entry; or
- I am a primary or secondary student with visitor status in Canada; or
- I am a visiting or exchange student with visitor status in Canada; or
- I am a student who has completed a program of study that is a prerequisite to my enrolment at a designated learning institution with visitor status in Canada; or
- I applied for permanent residence and was found eligible (first stage approval) under one of the following classes:
 - Spouse or Common-law Partner in Canada
 - Humanitarian and Compassionate cases
 - Protected Persons in Canada
 - Live-in Caregiver in Canada

You will now see **"Your results – Study permit"**. Click **"Continue"** to proceed to your document checklist. You will need to answer a few more questions.

Personal Checklist	Answers
When does your status in Canada expire?	Your visitor status expiry date
Have you had a medical exam performed by a CIC authorized panel physician (doctor) within the last 12 months?	Depending on your situation – if "yes", you must supply the UMI number.
Have lived in one or more <u>designated countries or territories</u> for more than 6 months in the last year?	No
Do you want to submit an application for a family member?	No
Are you giving someone access to your application?	No
There are fees associated with this application. Will you be paying your fees or are you fee exempt?	Yes, I will be paying my application fees.
Do you have the ability to create a digital image of your documents (through scanning or taking a picture) and will you pay your application fees online using a visa, MasterCard or American Express?	Yes. If you don't have a credit card, you can purchase a pre-paid visa.

You should now see your **Document Checklist**. Your personal reference code is at the top of the page – you will need to input this to continue your application online.

Signature	You don't need to print and sign the form – instead, click "Validate" and then save this version (the last page should be a bar code). This is the version that you will upload online.

Scan these supporting documents:

- digital photo (420x540 pixels)
- passport pages (all pages with stamps, visas, photos) saved as one single PDF document
- confirmation of enrolment letter from NSCC Registrar's Office – this letter also works as confirmation of your work term/co-op requirement
- proof of financial support (statement of balance from your bank)

3. Upload the IMM 5709 form and supporting documents.

4. Pay the application fee (\$150.00) with a credit card (VISA, MasterCard, American Express).

Please make sure you see the official receipt on the screen.

Submit the application.

Once your application has been successfully transmitted, you will see a confirmation of application submission under "My Messages".
