Other results include the production of a number of other promotional materials, development and distribution of displays, posters, newsletters and fact sheets, establishment of a Facebook group, and regular posting of web site updates. Information packages have been sent out to all NSCC campuses and all high schools in the Halifax Regional Municipality with resource materials on international development and the "Education Without

	Boundaries” Project. Also a number of events were either co-facilitated or organized reaching over 5,000 students and 500 staff members, as well as many local community members.
