



PROGRAM SUMMARY

The International Summer Academy in Engineering for Women is an intensive two-week program combining sophisticated theory with hands-on practical experience in engineering and natural sciences. The program also includes the topics of social, cross-cultural and gender issues discussed through lectures, seminars and workshops. Participants will also partake in a social/cultural program with site visits to attractions in Upper Austria.

The International Summer Academy in Engineering for Women is open to women between the ages of 17-26. The academy will take place July 11-26, 2023

- To identify and reflect on the differences and similarities between Canada and Austria.
